Pianist Position Overview

- Supports the worship of FBC King by providing piano accompaniment within the context of a small band, primarily on Sunday mornings and Wednesday nights
- Provides piano support for regular choral rehearsals on Wednesday nights and special called rehearsals (Such as Easter and Christmas)
- Ensures all assigned music is prepared and practiced in advance
- Arrives punctually on Sundays and Wednesdays for sound check
- Provides accompaniment for funerals and weddings (On request)
- Other duties assigned by the Minister of Music

Required Skills

- Excellent sight reading ability
- Ability to operate technology pursuant to the position. Currently includes in-ear personal monitor, and ipad
- Ability to play divergent choral parts in rehearsal. (Soprano & Tenor, Alto & Bass, etc.)
- Professional demeanor, ability to work effectively with others, evidence of organizational skills, punctuality, passion for worship
- Effective communication skills
- Some ability to improvise (i.e. play by ear) is preferred

Qualifications:

- A professing, born-again believer in Jesus Christ who exhibits maturity in his/her spiritual walk with the Lord
- At least 2 years of experience working with music in a Church setting, preferably Southern Baptist (Paid or volunteer)
- Willing to affirm the Baptist Faith and Message 2000 and become a member of FBC
- A Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university is preferred.
- Three relevant references are required
